

Greenhouse gas emissions throughout the supply chain

Toyo Aluminium Group supports the international climate objectives outlined in the Paris Agreement, including the global pathway toward achieving net-zero greenhouse gas emissions around mid-century, and recognizes its responsibility to contribute to the transition toward a decarbonized society.

As the first step in this effort, we have calculated our total greenhouse gas emissions across the entire supply chain in accordance with the GHG Protocol. Our total emissions for the base year, fiscal 2024, amounted to 940,000 tCO₂e.

Going forward, in addition to continuing energy-saving initiatives within our own operations, we will steadily advance efforts to reduce emissions across our supply chain.

We are also developing short-term targets aligned with the Science Based Targets (SBT) approach, while continuing to refine our calculation data. These targets will be announced in due course once finalized.

While recognizing that achieving carbon neutrality is a significant challenge, we will continue to make steady progress in reducing our emissions in line with these international frameworks and contribute to the realization of a sustainable future.
